London 376/384 Oxford Street /1 James Street.

One of the best located commercial premises in the UK. Rebuilt in the early 1950s, 376/384 Oxford Street was one of multiple Oxford Street sites for C&A. With purpose built offices on the 4th, 5th and 6th floor, the building provides a fantastically connected and accessible location for business in the West End of London.

The former retail tenant, Gap, departed at the end of 2021, presenting Redevco with the opportunity for major intervention and rejuvenation of the building. Works begin in Summer 2023 on a comprehensive scheme to increase the office provision, expand the building amenities (including roof terrace, business lounge and meeting space, cycle storage, multi faith room) and modernise the M&E and service provision to create a Well Platinum rated building, re-positioned for sustainable use well into the future.

Guildford White Lion Walk.

Acquired in 2019, Redevco saw the opportunity that White Lion Walk offered at the heart of the affluent, vibrant town of Guildford. Located 35 miles from Central London, Guildford offers a superb mix of commercial enterprise, business and commerce and a balance of urban/rural amenities and living.

Due to complete in April 2023, Redevco have undertaken a £7.5m refurbishment and redevelopment of White Lion Walk. The works included a repurposing of the first floor retail to provide c15,000sqft of prime office space and improving the shopping environment in keeping with long term ESG ambitions. A number of occupiers have been able to trade throughout the works, and the new look scheme will welcome a host of new additions throughout Summer 2023.

Brighton Hanningtons Estate.

Situated in the vibrant and exciting south coast city of Brighton, the Hanningtons Estate is an outstanding example of mixed use estate management. Dominated by the former Hanningtons Department store, the estate blends new development with repurposing, and now boasts over 40 retail and F&B occupiers, office suites and 60 + residential apartments and studios.

Redevco bought the estate in 2015, adding 38-42 East Street soon after. Since then, we have delivered a complex development in the department store's former service yard and surrounding buildings, and worked tirelessly to maintain and protect the heritage and history of the site. Hanningtons Lane, a new retail destination, is the result – a superb blend of independent retailers, coffee shops and restaurants. This, alongside the complete repositioning of the public realm and tenant mix at the southern end of North Street, has delivered on the potential of such an important and iconic location in Brighton.

Our work is focussed on the longevity and future for Hanningtons, creating a 'circular community' where all our residents – commercial or private – strengthen and support each other, as well as the Estate, to create a sustainable and liveable place long into the future

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


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
